SINGLE STREAM CURBSIDE RECYCLING BEGINS THIS WEEK - JANUARY 7, 2015

The recycling bins (toters) have been delivered to the properties that receive the Borough's trash service. If you did not obtain a toter please contact the Borough office at 610.593.6854.

Place in the recycling toter all recycled materials. Recycling will be picked up on Wednesdays - the same day as your trash. Place your trash and recycling toters out for curbside service.

This service begins on January 7th.

What can be recycled?

- All plastic containers from # 1 through # 5 and #7
- Glass bottles and jars
- Aluminum & metal cans
- Newspaper
- Mixed paper
- Mail (we recommend shredding personal mail prior to recycling)
- Cardboard. Breakdown and cut up the cardboard packaging to fit into the recycling container

What is not allowed in the recycling toter?

- Household trash
- Plastic shopping bags
- Styrofoam or foam packaging (egg cartons, meat/produce trays)
- Scrap metal
- Diapers
- Hazardous wastes
- Paper towels or tissue paper
- Textiles, fabric or clothing
- Ceramics, chinaware, porcelain or pyrex dishes
- Books or toys
- Liquids
- Mirrors and window glass
- Light bulbs
- Batteries
- Syringes or needles
- Computer or electronic equipment

You no longer can drop off recyclables at the Borough Garage. The large containers have been removed.
