Single Stream Curbside Recycling

This is Year One of curbside recycling. The results for the first four months of the year have exceeded our projections. Thirty-five tons of material was collected! Thanks for participating. Key recycling points:

- There is no limit to what you generate. You can fill up more than 1 recycling can.
- Place the recycling container(s) next to your trash can on Tuesday evenings.
- Eligible items: Glass; plastic containers; metal cans; newspaper; mixed paper; shredded paper; and cardboard that is broken down and placed in the container or tied into bundles.
- If you do not see your neighbor putting out recyclables introduce him/her to the program.
