DROUGHT WATCH

The Governor's Office has declared a drought watch for Chester County. For Atglen Borough our public water supply system is fed by three wells. We are monitoring our wells; and, the supply is adequate to meet our needs. To comply with the directive from the Governor's Office we are asking the community to voluntarily reduce their water consumption.

FLUSHING FIRE HYDRANTS

WE WILL POSTPONE THIS MAINTENANCE ACTIVITY IF THE DROUGHT WATCH IS **STILL IN EFFECT. PLEASE** CHECK IN WITH THE **BOROUGH HALL OFFICE OR LOOK ON THE BOROUGH WEBSITE FOR CURRENT INFORMATION.**

Twice a year, in the Spring and Fall, we flush the water mains in our distribution system by opening up the fire hydrants. This cleans out the build-up of mineral deposits and sediment inside the water main lines. Also, we test our hydrants for fire flows.

DISCOLORATION AND CLOUDY WATER

Your water may appear discolored or cloudy the day of and the day after the flushing. This is due to the movement of the sediment in the water lines. If this happens it is not harmful. Let your water run until it becomes clear.

WHAT SHOULD I DO TO PREPARE A DAY OR TWO **BEFORE THE FLUSHING**

- Wash your laundry. Run your dishwasher.
- Store a pitcher or bottle of water in your refrigerator for drinking and cooking.

If you operate your clothes washer during the flushing event and your laundry appears stained do not use bleach and do not put your wet laundry in the dryer. Rewash the clothes using more detergent after you have confirmed the water is running clear.

COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

The Borough received a Chester County Vision Partnership grant to create a new Comprehensive Plan. The Taskforce will look at the past, current, and ten years in the future in order to develop an implementable issue based strategic plan. The Taskforce members consist of three Council persons, the Mayor, two planners from the Planning Commission, and the Borough Manager. The Chester County Planning Department will serve as the consultant.
