COMPREHENSIVE AND REVITALIZATION PLAN

In Year 2016 Atglen Borough received a Chester County Vision Partnership Program Grant to update the Borough's Comprehensive and Revitalization Plan. A Comp Plan Task Force was formed and met regularly for the past two years to develop the Borough's blueprint for the future. The proposed plan is complete and available for your review at Borough Hall or on-line at the Borough's website, www.atglen.org. The public hearing required as part of the adoption process is scheduled for November 5 at 7 pm in Atglen Borough Hall.

PUBLIC WATER INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS TO WELL #4 AND RIDGE AVENUE WATER LINES

Last year the Chester County Board of Commissioners awarded to the Borough a \$ 450,000 Community Revitalization Program Grant. The project was for the installation of a nitrate removal system on Public Water Well #4, an emergency generator and safety features for Well #4, and the replacement of some water lines on Ridge Avenue. The Borough completed the design and went out to bid in August. The bids are being reviewed as of the writing of this newsletter. We hope to get construction underway in late Fall.

**LEAF
COLLECTION**

Weather permitting; leaf collection will take place every Monday beginning Monday, October 29th and continue until December. Rake your leaves into a pile along the gutter. Remove branches, grass cuttings and other debris.

Our leaf collection equipment is 12 feet high. If you have tree limbs that hang less than 12 feet above the road, trim the limbs to prevent breakage.

STORMWATER MANAGEMENT TIPS

- Keep the streets and storm inlets clean of litter and grass clippings.
- If weeds are growing between the street and curb remove the weeds.
- Pick up dog waste.
