

An Ordinance 148

Regulating the sale and discharge of fireworks in the Borough of Atglen, Pennsylvania.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Atglen, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. From and after the passage of this ordinance it shall be unlawful within the corporative limits of Atglen for any person or persons, firms or corporation to sell or offer for sale any fireworks of any kind, character or composition including therein, firecrackers, torpedoes or hand or set pieces or percussion caps or dynamite at any time. Possession by any firm or corporation or person shall be deemed evidence of the intent to sell the same.

Section 2. From and after the passage of this ordinance it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to ignite, put off or discharge any fireworks of any kind or character or composition, including therein firecrackers, torpedoes, percussion caps or dynamite, exhibition or set pieces or blank cartridges. Sparklers will be allowed July 3rd and July 4th only.


Section 3. Exhibition or set pieces may be put off by a firm or by their principal, or agents or employees or persons on procuring a permit issued by the Mayor and after the approval of the Council of the Borough of Atglen.


Section 4. Any person whether as principal, agent or employee of any firm or corporation violating the provisions of

this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars, nor more than three hundred (\$300.00) dollars, and in default thereof shall suffer imprisonment of not less than five (5) nor more than ten (10) days.

Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith, the same are hereby repealed and Ordinance #54 is hereby specifically repealed.
