ORDINANCE NO. 312-99  
Amending Ordinance 228

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Council of the Borough of Atglen, Chester County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Atglen by this Ordinance hereby amends Ordinances 228 known and cited as the "Dog Ordinance of the Borough of Atglen." This Ordinance hereby establishes the following:


- O. It shall be unlawful to own, harbor or keep in custody any dog which disturbs the peace by barking, howling or making other loud noises to the annoyance and discomfort of any person in the Borough of Atglen. Barking, howling or the making of other loud noises by such animal for more than fifteen (15) minutes shall be deemed and presumed to disturb the peace and to cause the annoyance and discomfort of persons in the Borough of Atglen.

Section 2. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of the provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional or void, such decision shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of the Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional or void provision not been included therein.


