We have good news in that the sewer and water rates are remaining as is, unchanged. The trash and recycling fee will increase by \$18 per quarter. Why, you may ask? Our current 5 year trash and recycling contract with AJ Blosenski expires at the end of this year. The low bidder on the new trash and recycling contract was AJ Blosenski. With the new contract comes additional costs. The new quarterly trash rate is \$104 effective December 1.
